THE CREATION

1 "In the beginning bGod created the heavens and the earth. The earth was 'aformless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was moving over the surface of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. God saw that the light was good; and God beparated the light from the darkness. God called the light day, and the darkness He called night. And there was evening and there was morning, one day.

⁶Then God said, "Let there be ⁴an ^aexpanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." 7God made the ⁵expanse, and separated ^athe waters which were below the ⁵expanse from the waters ^bwhich were above the ⁵expanse; and it was so. ⁸God called the ⁵expanse heaven. And there was evening and there was morning, a second day.

⁹Then God said, "aLet the waters below the heavens be gathered into one place, and let bthe dry land appear"; and it was so. ¹⁰God called the dry land earth, and the agathering of the waters He called seas; and God saw that it was good. ¹¹Then God said, "Let the earth sprout after their the earth sprout after their kind with seed in them"; and it was so. ¹²The earth brought forth

⁶vegetation, ⁷plants yielding seed after ⁸their kind, and trees bearing fruit ⁹with seed in them, after ⁸their kind; and God saw that it was good. ¹³There was evening and there was morning, a third day.

14 Then God said. "Let there be 10 a lights in the 5 bexpanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for descapons and for days and years; 15 and let them be for 10 lights in the ⁵expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so. ¹⁶God made the two ¹⁰great lights, the agreater "light 12 to govern the day, and the lesser "light 12 to govern the night; He made bthe stars also. ¹⁷ God placed them in the ⁵ expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, 18 and 12 to agovern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good. 19 There was evening and there was morning, a fourth day.

²⁰Then God said, "Let the waters 'steem with swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth 'sin the open 'sexpanse of the heavens." ²¹God created 'sthe great sea monsters and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarmed after their kind, and

every winged bird after its kind; and God saw that it was good. ²² God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." ²³ There was evening and there was morning, a fifth day.

24°Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures after 'their kind: cattle and creeping things and beasts of the earth after 'their kind"; and it was so. 25 God made the "beasts of the earth after 'their kind, and the cattle after 'their kind, and everything that creeps on the ground after its kind; and God saw that it was good.

26 Then God said, "Let "Us make bman in Our image, according to Our likeness: and let them 'rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the 2sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." 27 God created man ain His own image, in the image of God He created him; bmale and female He created them. 28 God blessed them; and God said to them, "aBe fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the 2sky and over every living thing that 3 moves on the earth." 29 Then God said, "Behold, "I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the 4 surface of all the earth, and every tree 5 which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you; 30 and ato every beast of the earth and to every bird of the 2sky and to every thing that 3moves on

the earth ⁶which has life, *I have given* every green plant for food"; and it was so. ³¹God saw all that He had made, and behold, it was very ⁶good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

THE CREATION OF MAN AND WOMAN

Thus the heavens and the earth were completed, and all "their hosts. ²By "the seventh day God completed His work which He had done, and ^bHe rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. ³Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created ⁷ and made.

48aThis is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in bthe day that the LORD God made earth and heaven, 5ª Now no shrub of the field was yet in the earth, and no plant of the field had vet sprouted. bfor the LORD God had not sent rain upon the earth, and there was no man to ocultivate the ground. 6 But a 10 mist used to rise from the earth and water the whole 4surface of the ground. 7Then the LORD God formed man of adust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life: and bman became a living "being. 8The LORD God planted a agarden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed. 9 Out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow ^a every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; bthe tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

15 Then the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it. 16 The LORD God acommanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; 17 but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die."

18 Then the LORD God said. "It is not good for the man to be alone; ^aI will make him a helper ⁷ suitable for him." 19a Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the 8sky, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them: and whatever the man called a living creature, that was its name. 20 The man gave names to all the cattle, and to the birds of the 8skv, and to every beast of the field, but for 9Adam there was not found a helper suitable for him. 21 So the LORD God caused a "deep sleep to fall upon the man. and he slept; then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place. 22 The LORD God 10 fashioned into a woman athe rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. 23 The man said.

"aThis is now bone of my bones, And flesh of my flesh;

"She shall be called "Woman.

Because "she was taken out of 13 Man."

24° For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and be joined to his wife; and they shall become one flesh. ²⁵° And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed

THE FALL OF MAN

Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Indeed, has God said. 'You shall not eat from 14 any tree of the garden'?" 2The woman said to the serpent, "a From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat: 3 but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said. 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die." 4ª The serpent said to the woman, "You surely will not die! 5 For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and ayou will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6° When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make *one* wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate. 7Then the eves of both of them were opened, and they aknew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves ¹⁵loin coverings.

And more than every beast of the field;
On your belly you will go,
And bdust you will eat
All the days of your life;

I5 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her seed; bHe shall bruise you

on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel."

To the woman He said, "I will greatly multiply Your pain in childbirth, In pain you will bring forth children; Yet your desire will be for your husband,

it shall grow for you; And you will eat the *plants of the field;

19 By the sweat of your face You will eat bread, Till you ^areturn to the ground, Because ^b from it you were taken; For you are dust,

And to dust you shall return."

²⁰ Now the man called his wife's name ^{5a} Eve, because she was the mother of all *the* living. ²¹ The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

22 Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of "US, knowing good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take also from bthe tree of life, and eat, and live forever"—23 therefore the LORD God sent him out from the garden of Eden, to cultivate the ground from which he was taken. 24 So "He drove the man out; and at the beast of the garden of Eden He stationed the 'cherubim and the flaming sword which turned every direction to guard the way to dthe tree of life.

CAIN AND ABEL

4 Now the man ⁶had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and gave birth to ⁷Cain, and she said, "I have gotten a ⁸manchild with *the help of* the LORD." ²Again,

she gave birth to his brother Abel. And "Abel was ba keeper of flocks. but Cain was a tiller of the ground. 3So it came about 'in the course of time that Cain brought an offering to the LORD of the fruit of the ground. 4^aAbel, on his part also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions. And bthe LORD had regard for Abel and for his offering: 5 but a for Cain and for his offering He had no regard. So bCain became very angry and his countenance fell. ⁶Then the LORD said to Cain, "^aWhy are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? 7ª If you do well. ²will not your countenance be lifted up? bAnd if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, 'but you must master it." ⁸Cain ³told Abel his brother. And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and akilled him.

9Then the LORD said to Cain. "aWhere is Abel your brother?" And he said, "I do not know. Am I my brother's keeper?" 10 He said, "What have you done? aThe voice of your brother's blood is crying to Me from the ground. II Now ayou are cursed from the ground, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand. 12 aWhen you cultivate the ground, it will no longer yield its strength to you; byou will be a vagrant and a wanderer on the earth." 13 Cain said to the LORD. "My punishment is too great to bear! 14 Behold, You have a driven me this day from the face of the ground; and from Your face I will be hidden, and ^bI will be a vagrant and a wanderer on the earth, and 'whoever finds me will kill me." 15 So the LORD said to him. "Therefore whoever kills Cain. vengeance will be taken on him ^asevenfold." And the LORD ^{ab}appointed a sign for Cain, so that no one finding him would slay him.

DESCENDANTS OF ADAM

5 This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day when God created man, He made him "in the likeness of God. ²He created them "male and female, and He blessed them and named them "Man in the day when they were created.

³When Adam had lived one hundred and thirty years, he ⁵became the father of *a son* in his own likeness, according to his image, and named him Seth. ⁴Then the days of Adam after he became the father of Seth were eight hundred years, and he had *other* sons and daughters. ⁵So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years, and he died.

⁶Seth lived one hundred and five years, and became the father of Enosh. ⁷Then Seth lived eight hundred and seven years after he became the father of Enosh, and he had *other* sons and daughters. ⁸So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years, and he died.

⁹Enosh lived ninety years, and became the father of Kenan. ¹⁰Then Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years after he became the father of Kenan, and he had *other* sons and daughters. ¹¹So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years, and he died.

¹²Kenan lived seventy years, and became the father of Mahalalel.

¹⁸ Jared lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and became the father of Enoch. ¹⁹ Then Jared lived eight hundred years after he became the father of Enoch, and he had other sons and daughters. ²⁰ So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years, and he died.

²¹Enoch lived sixty-five years, and became the father of Methuselah. ²²Then Enoch ^awalked with God three hundred years after he became the father of Methuselah, and he had other sons and daughters. ²³So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. ²⁴ Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God ^b took him.

²⁵Methuselah lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and became the father of Lamech. ²⁶Then Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years after he became the father of Lamech, and he had *other* sons and daughters. ²⁷So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years, and he died.

²⁸Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and became the father of a son. ²⁹Now he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will ⁶give us rest from our work and from the toil of our hands *arising* from ^athe ground which the LORD has

cursed." 30 Then Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years after he became the father of Noah, and he had *other* sons and daughters. 31 So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years, and he died.

³²Noah was ^afive hundred years old, and Noah became the father of Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

THE CORRUPTION OF MANKIND

6 Now it came about, when men began to multiply on the face of the land, and daughters were born to them, 2 that the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were 'beautiful; and they took wives for themselves, whomever they chose, 3 Then the LORD said, "aMy Spirit shall not ²strive with man forever. ³^bbecause he also is flesh: 4nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years." 4The "Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men, and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.

5Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that "every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. ⁶ The LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was "grieved "in His heart. The LORD said, "aI will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the "sky; for "I am sorry that I have made them." ⁸ But "Noah "found favor in the eyes of the LORD.

teous man, ^{7b}blameless in his ⁸time; Noah ^cwalked with God. ¹⁰Noah ⁹became the father of three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

II Now the earth was "corrupt in the sight of God, and the earth was "filled with violence. I2 God looked on the earth, and behold, it was corrupt; for "all flesh had corrupted their way upon the earth.

13 Then God said to Noah. "a The end of all flesh has come before Me: for the earth is filled with violence because of them; and behold, I am about to destroy them with the earth. 14 Make for yourself an ark of gopher wood; you shall make the ark with rooms, and shall ¹⁰cover it inside and out with pitch. 15 This is how you shall make it: the length of the ark three hundred "cubits, its breadth fifty "cubits, and its height thirty "cubits. 16 You shall make a ¹²window for the ark, and finish it to a cubit from 13 the top; and set the door of the ark in the side of it; you shall make it with lower, second, and third decks. 17 Behold, al, even I am bringing the flood of water upon the earth, to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life, from under heaven; everything that is on the earth shall perish. 18 But I will establish aMv covenant with vou: and byou shall enter the ark—you and your sons and your wife, and your sons' wives with you. 19 And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every kind into the ark, to keep them alive with you; they shall be male and female. 20 a Of the

THE FLOOD

Then the LORD said to Noah, "Enter the ark, you and all your household, for you alone I have seen to be arighteous before Me in this 'time. 2 You shall take 'with you of every "clean animal "by sevens, a male and his female: and of the animals that are not clean two, a male and his female: 3 also of the birds of the 4sky, 3by sevens, male and female, to keep 5 offspring alive on the face of all the earth. 4 For after aseven more days, I will send rain on the earth bforty days and forty nights; and I will blot out from the face of the land 'every living thing that I have made." 5ª Noah did according to all that the LORD had commanded him.

⁶Now Noah was "six hundred years old when the flood of water "came upon the earth. ⁷Then "Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him entered the ark because of the water of the flood. ⁸"Of clean animals and animals that are not clean and birds and everything that creeps on the ground, ⁹there

went into the ark to Noah ⁷by twos, male and female, as God had commanded Noah. ¹⁰ It came about after ^ethe seven days, that the water of the flood ⁸came upon the earth. ¹¹ In the ^esix hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, on the seventeenth day of the month, on the same day all ⁸the fountains of the great deep burst open, and the ⁹floodgates of the sky were opened. ¹²eThe rain ⁶fell upon the earth for forty days and forty nights.

13On the very same day aNoah and Shem and Ham and Japheth. the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife and the three wives of his sons with them, entered the ark, 14 they and every beast after its kind, and all the cattle after 10 their kind, and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth after its kind, and every bird after its kind, "all sorts of birds. 15 So they went into the ark to Noah. ^aby twos of all flesh in which was the breath of life. 16 Those that entered, male and female of all flesh, entered as God had commanded him: and the LORD closed it behind him.

¹⁷Then the flood ⁶came upon the earth for a forty days, and the water increased and lifted up the ark, so that it rose above the earth. 18 The water prevailed and increased greatly upon the earth, and the ark ¹²floated on the ¹³surface of the water. 19 The water prevailed more and more upon the earth, so that all the high mountains 4everywhere under the heavens were covered. 20 The water prevailed fifteen ¹⁵ cubits higher. and the mountains were covered. 21a All flesh that 16 moved on the earth perished, birds and cattle and beasts and every swarming thing that swarms upon the earth. and all mankind: 22 of all that was on II GENESIS · 7-8

the dry land, all "in whose nostrils was the breath of the spirit of life, died. ²³Thus He blotted out 'every living thing that was upon the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the 'sky, and they were blotted out from the earth; and only "Noah was left, together with those that were with him in the ark. ²⁴The water prevailed upon the earth one hundred and fifty days.

THE FLOOD SUBSIDES

O But "God remembered Noah and O all the beasts and all the cattle that were with him in the ark; and ^bGod caused a wind to pass over the earth, and the water subsided. 2 Also athe fountains of the deep and the 3floodgates of the sky were closed. and bthe rain from the sky was restrained: 3 and the water receded steadily from the earth, and at the end of one hundred and fifty days the water decreased. 4In the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, athe ark rested upon the mountains of Ararat. 5 The water decreased steadily until the tenth month; in the tenth month, on the first day of the month, the tops of the mountains became visible.

6Then it came about at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the "window of the ark which he had made; ⁷ and he sent out a raven, and it ⁴flew here and there until the water was dried up ⁵from the earth. ⁸Then he sent out a dove from him, to see if the water was abated from the face of the land; ⁹ but the dove found no resting place for the sole of her foot, so she returned to him into the ark, for the water was on the ⁶ surface of all the earth. Then he put out his hand and took her.

and brought her into the ark to himself. ¹⁰So he waited yet another seven days; and again he sent out the dove from the ark. ¹¹The dove came to him toward ⁷evening, and behold, in her ⁸beak was a freshly picked olive leaf. So Noah knew that the water was abated from the earth. ¹²Then he waited yet another seven days, and sent out ^ethe dove; but she did not return to him again.

13 Now it came about in the asix hundred and first year, in the first month, on the first of the month, the water was dried up 5 from the earth. Then Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and behold, the 'surface of the ground was dried up. 14 In the second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month, the earth was dry. 15 Then God spoke to Noah, saying, 16 "Go out of the ark, you and your wife and your sons and vour sons' wives with vou. 17 Bring out with you every living thing of all flesh that is with you, birds and animals and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth, that they may ^{9a}breed abundantly on the earth, and be fruitful and multiply on the earth." 18 So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him. 19 Every beast, every creeping thing, and every bird, everything that moves on the earth, went out ¹⁰by their families from the ark.

²⁰Then Noah built ^aan altar to the LORD, and took of every ^bclean animal and of every clean bird and offered ^cburnt offerings on the altar. ²¹The LORD ^asmelled the soothing aroma: and the LORD said "to Him-

COVENANT OF THE RAINBOW

And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, "a Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth. ²The fear of you and the terror of you will be on every beast of the earth and on every bird of the 3sky; with everything that creeps on the ground, and all the fish of the sea, into your hand they are given. 3 Every moving thing that is alive shall be food for you; I give all to you, as I gave the green plant, 40nly you shall not eat flesh with its life, that is. "its blood. 5 Surely I will require ^{4a}your lifeblood; ^{5b} from every beast I will require it. And 5 from every man, 5 from every man's brother I will require the life of man.

6 "aWhoever sheds man's blood, By man his blood shall be shed, For bin the image of God He made man.

7 "As for you, "be fruitful and multiply; 6 Populate the earth abundantly and multiply in it."

⁸Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying, ⁹"Now

"This is the sign of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that is on the earth."

¹⁸ Now the sons of Noah who came out of the ark were Shem and Ham and Japheth; and ^aHam was the father of Canaan. ¹⁹ These three *were* the sons of Noah, and ^afrom these the whole earth was ^apopulated.

20 Then Noah began of farming and planted a vineyard. 21 He drank of the wine and obecame drunk, and uncovered himself inside his tent.
