

prophet. ⁵³And every man went unto his own house.

8 Jesus went unto the mount of Olives. ²And early in the morning he came again into the temple, and all the people came unto him; and he sat down, and taught them. ³And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst, ⁴they say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act. ⁵Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou? ⁶This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground, *as though he heard them not*. ⁷So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, **He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.** ⁸And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground. ⁹And they which heard it, ^abeing convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, *even* unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. ¹⁰When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, **Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?** ¹¹She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, **Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.**

¹²Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.** ¹³The Pharisees therefore said unto him, ^aThou bearest record of thyself; thy record is not true. ¹⁴Jesus answered and said unto them, **Though I bear record of myself, yet my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.** ¹⁵*Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.* ¹⁶And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for ^aI am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me. ¹⁷*It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true.* ¹⁸I am one that bear witness of myself, and ^athe Father that sent me beareth witness of me. ¹⁹Then said they unto him, *Where is thy Father?* Jesus answered, **Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.** ²⁰These words spake Jesus in ^athe treasury, as he taught in the temple: and ^bno man laid hands on him; for ^chis hour was not yet come.

²¹Then said Jesus again unto them, **I go my way, and ye shall seek me, and shall die in your sins: whither I go, ye cannot**

come. ²²Then said the Jews, Will he kill himself? because he saith, Whither I go, ye cannot come. ²³And he said unto them, **Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world.** ²⁴*I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.* ²⁵Then said they unto him, Who art thou? And Jesus saith unto them, *Even the same that I said unto you from the beginning.* ²⁶I have many things to say and to judge of you: but ^ahe that sent me is true; and ^bI speak to the world those things which I have heard of him. ²⁷They understood not that he spake to them of the Father. ²⁸Then said Jesus unto them, *When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.* ²⁹And ^ahe that sent me is with me: ^bthe Father hath not left me alone; ^cfor I do always those things that please him. ³⁰As he spake these words, ^amany believed on him.

³¹Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, *If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.* ³²They answered him, *We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?* ³³Jesus answered them, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.* ³⁴And ^athe servant abideth not in the house for ever: ^bbut the Son abideth ever. ³⁵*If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.* ³⁶I know that ye are Abraham's seed; but ^aye seek to kill me, because my word hath no place in you. ³⁷*I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.* ³⁸They answered and said unto him, *Abraham is our father.* Jesus saith unto them, *If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham.* ³⁹*Now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.* ⁴⁰*Ye do the deeds of your father.*

Then said they to him, *We be not born of fornication: we have one Father, even God.* ⁴¹Jesus said unto them, *If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.* ⁴²*Why do ye not understand my speech? even because ye cannot hear my word.* ⁴³*Ye are of your fa-*
